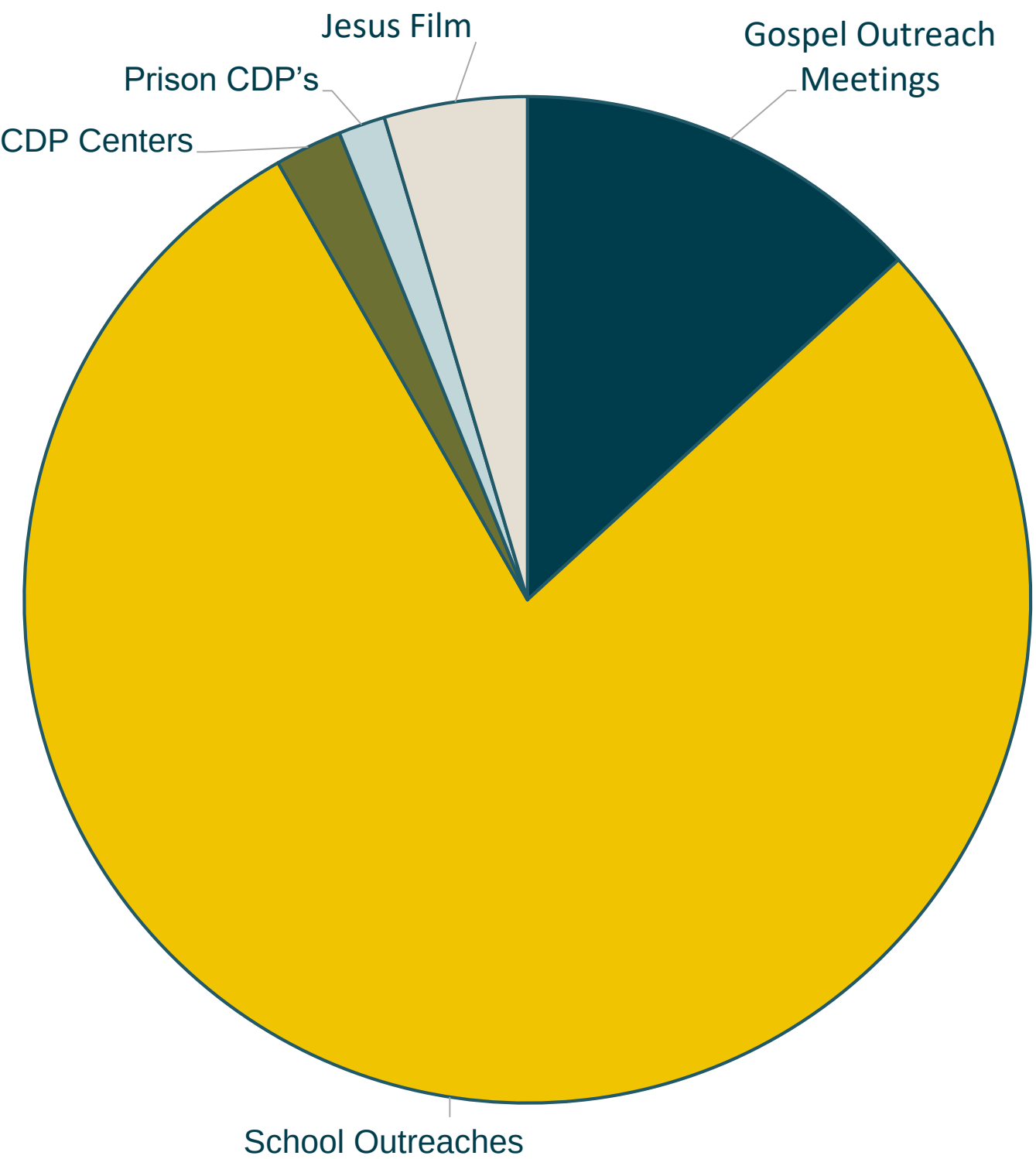

Tanzania

Q2 Overview

During the second quarter in Tanzania, we focused our efforts on the Isanzu and Makomero areas within the Tabora region, sharing the Gospel message.

Our Gospel Outreach meetings in both villages were met with remarkable success, as hundreds embraced faith in Jesus, and many experienced healing from various ailments. We received numerous testimonies of healing, restored marriages, and new job opportunities, highlighting the impact of our efforts.

During the Christian Discipleship Programs (CDPs) we welcomed many enthusiastic pastors who were thrilled to witness the transformation of lives as hundreds surrendered to Christ. Our days began with door-to-door evangelism, followed by teachings in the afternoon, and concluded with a screening of a Jesus film in the evening.

Additionally, we took the message of Jesus to several prisons, including Handeni, Korogwe, Kwamgumi, Maweni Maximum, and Tanga Reminders. The arrival of the Jesus Alive Team has been a significant blessing in these facilities, which have often been overlooked by the local Christian community. In a district where the Muslim population predominates and Christians are a minority, our mission was to offer the inmates a life-changing message of hope by giving them an opportunity to put their faith in Jesus Christ.

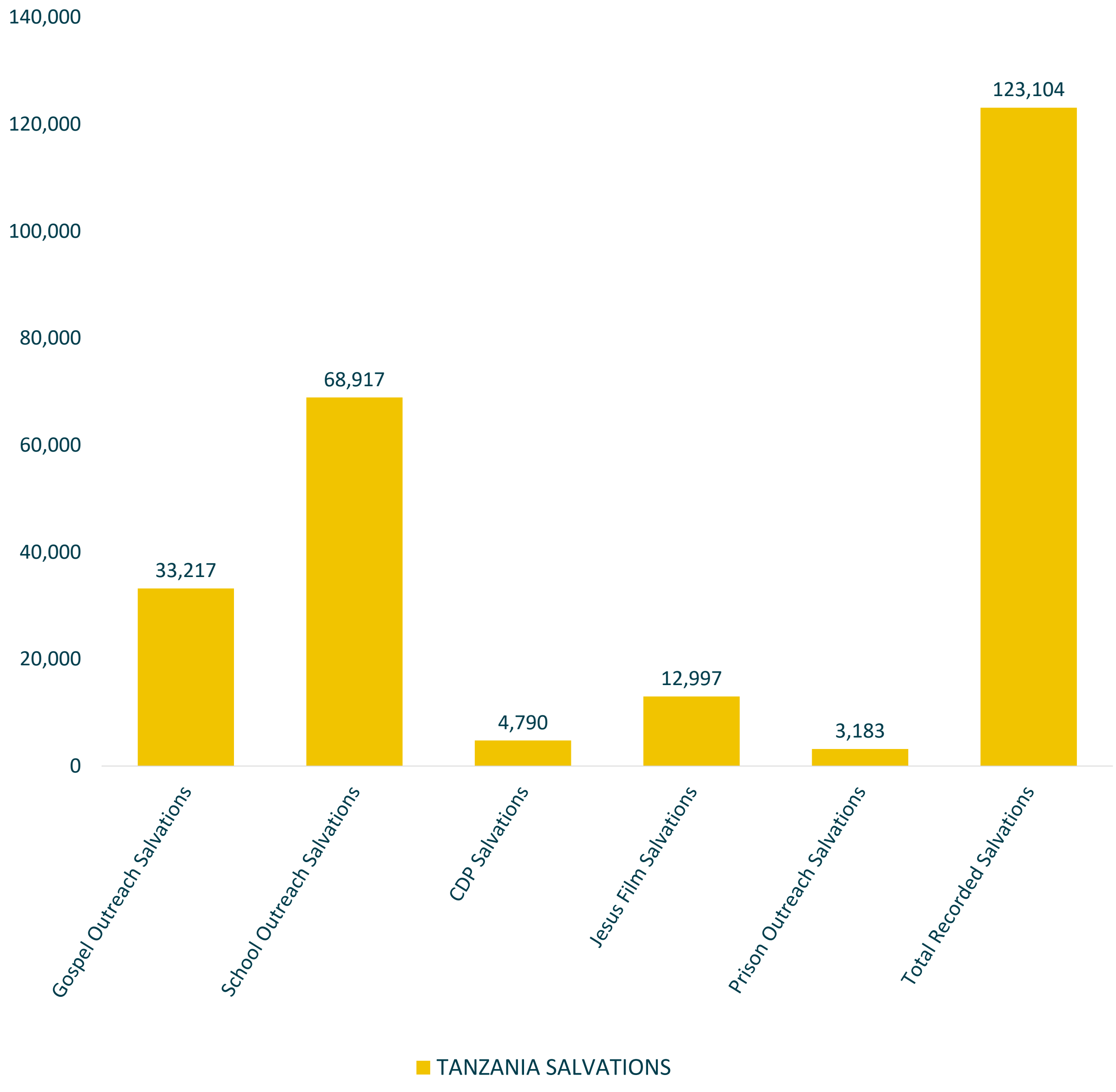

Handeni Prison Outreach

The arrival of the Jesus Alive Team at Handeni Prison has revitalized this often-overlooked institution, particularly in a district where the Muslim community predominates and Christians are a minority. This outreach is crucial in providing spiritual support and a sense of community, helping to bridge the gap between the prison and the surrounding society.

The ministry dedicated to sharing the Word of God with the prisoners proved to be incredibly impactful, as every individual who participated in the service embraced Jesus as their Lord and Savior!

The Warden expressed a strong desire for the Jesus Alive Team to return, highlighting the scarcity of spiritual services in many correctional facilities, which often leads to inmates reoffending after their release. The humanitarian aid provided was met with heartfelt appreciation, and the response to Joyce Meyer's booklet was overwhelmingly positive. Additionally, the teaching materials, including a teaching flash drive, a generator, and a 43-inch flat-screen TV, were well-received. We are truly grateful to God for the success of this ministry and the positive impact it has had on the lives of the prisoners.

Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC)

Q2 Overview

In the DRC, our team conducted outreach activities in the Haut-Katanga Region, which is a southeastern province of the Democratic Republic of the Congo, established in 2015 following the division of the historic Katanga province.

The Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) is grappling with significant challenges, including a violent armed conflict in the east involving rebel factions, a widespread displacement and hunger crisis, pervasive corruption and ineffective governance, as well as recurring disease outbreaks such as the ongoing Ebola crisis, which has claimed over 2000 lives. These areas also face difficulties such as a lack of electricity, clean water, and adequate social facilities

We organized both Gospel Outreaches and Christian Discipleship Programs in the Boma and Kabilele Villages. Despite all of these hardships, our outreach was fruitful; the pastors who participated in the Christian Discipleship Program also expressed a strong sense of unity among themselves.

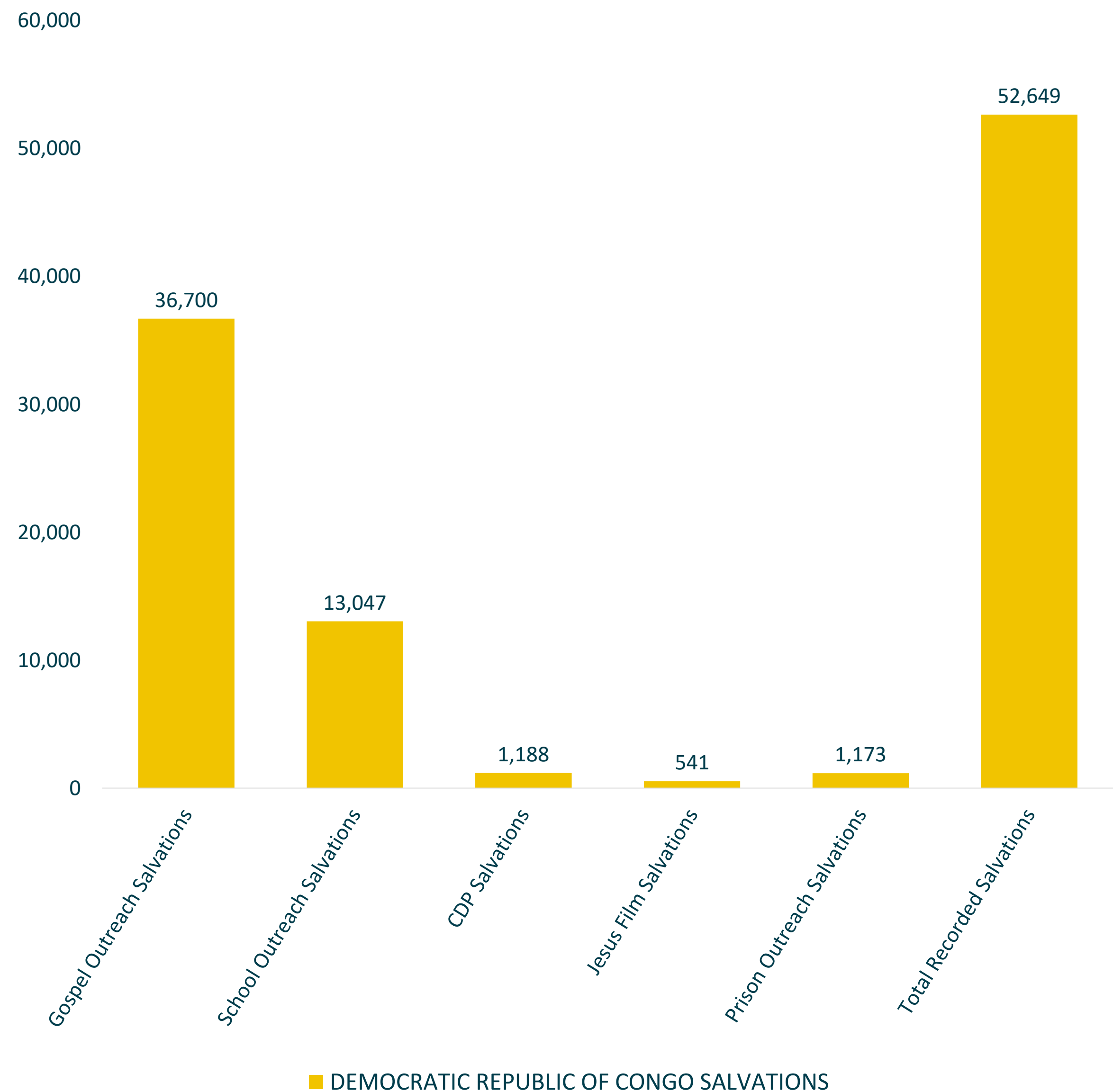
We are immensely grateful to God for the numerous healings, deliverances, and answered prayers! We praise God for the 15,100 decisions made for Jesus in these villages.

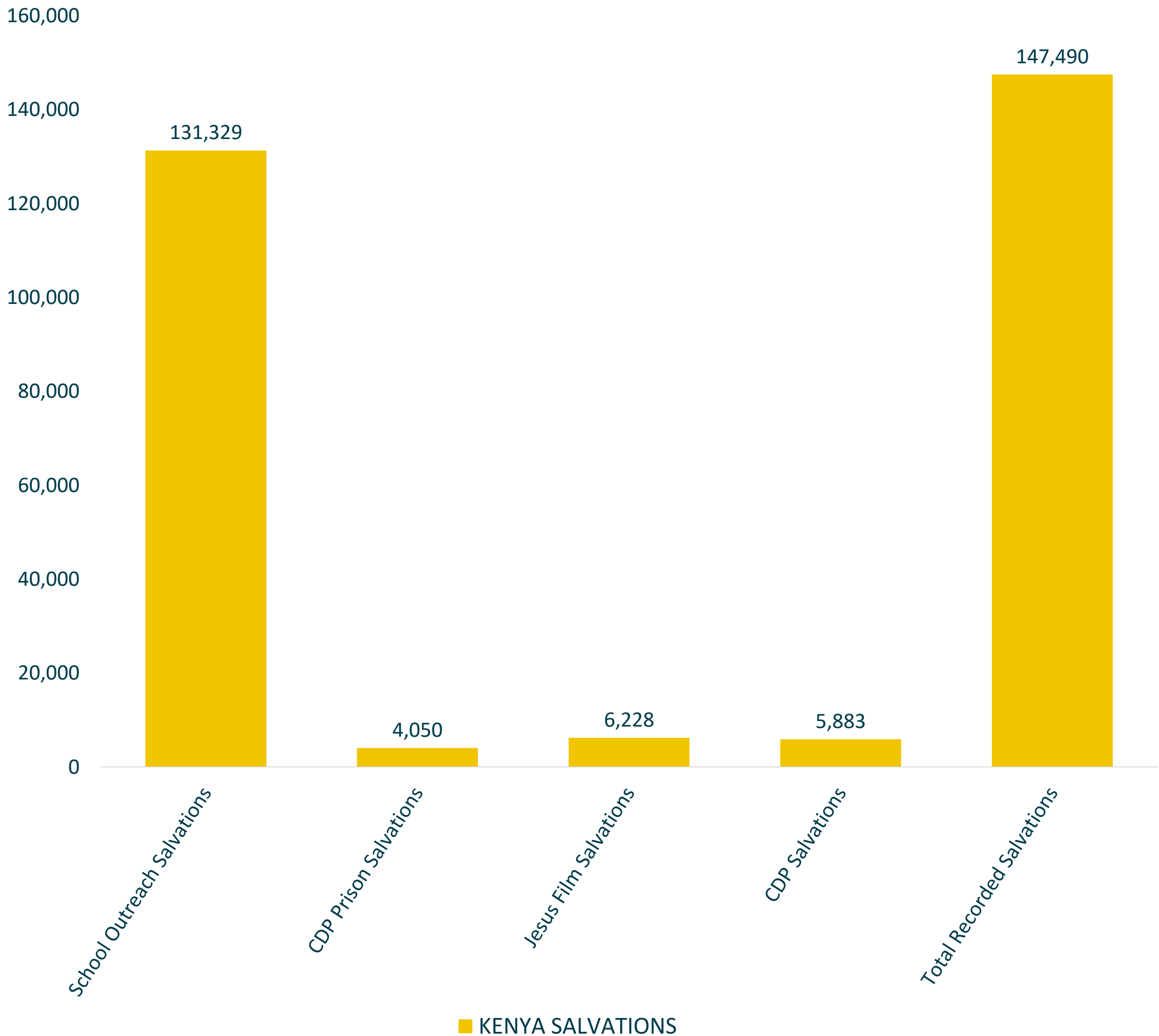

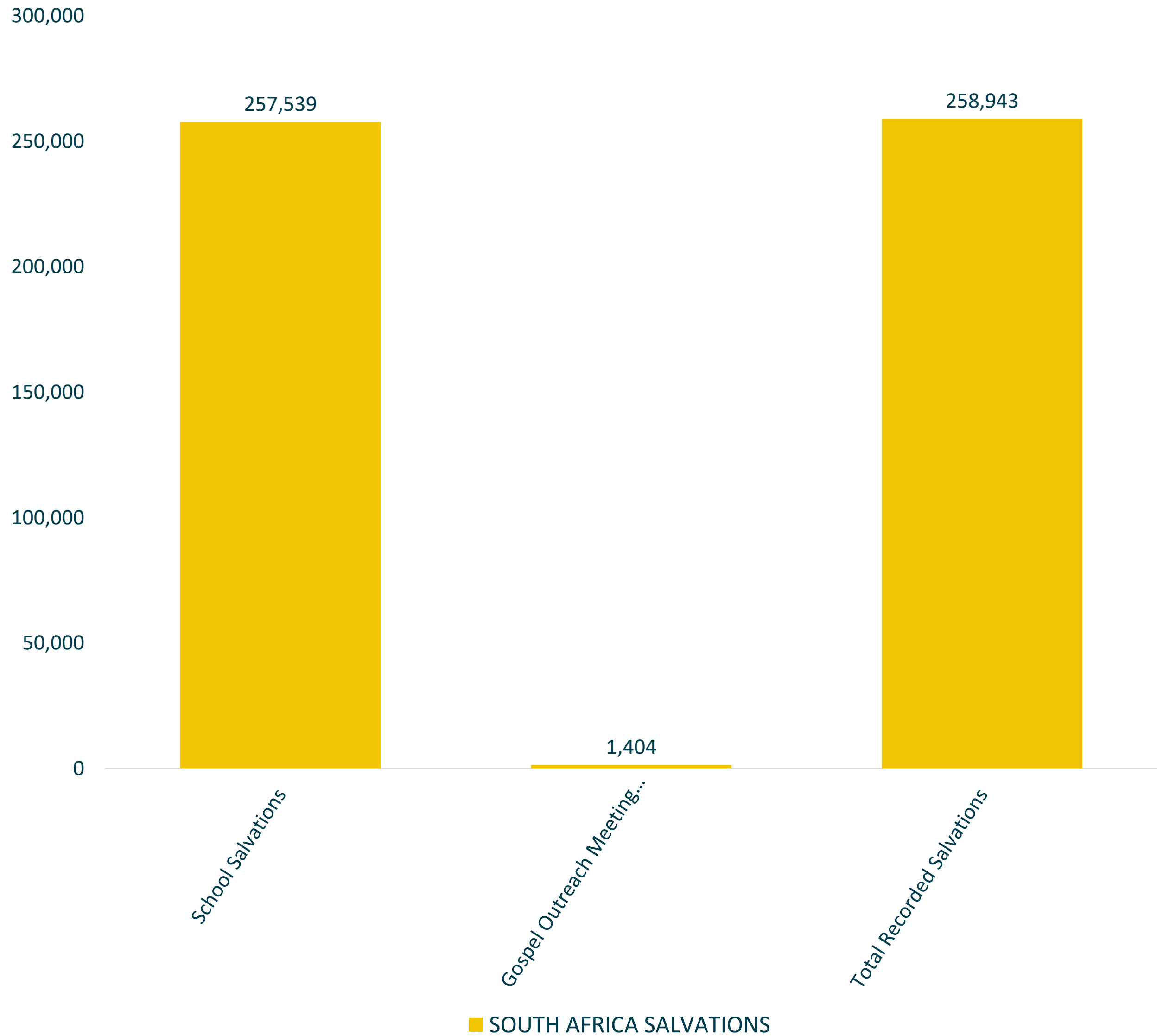

I challenged him not to waste the privilege he and his team have to shape those little lives.

In Awerial village, this marked the very first Gospel outreach in the area!

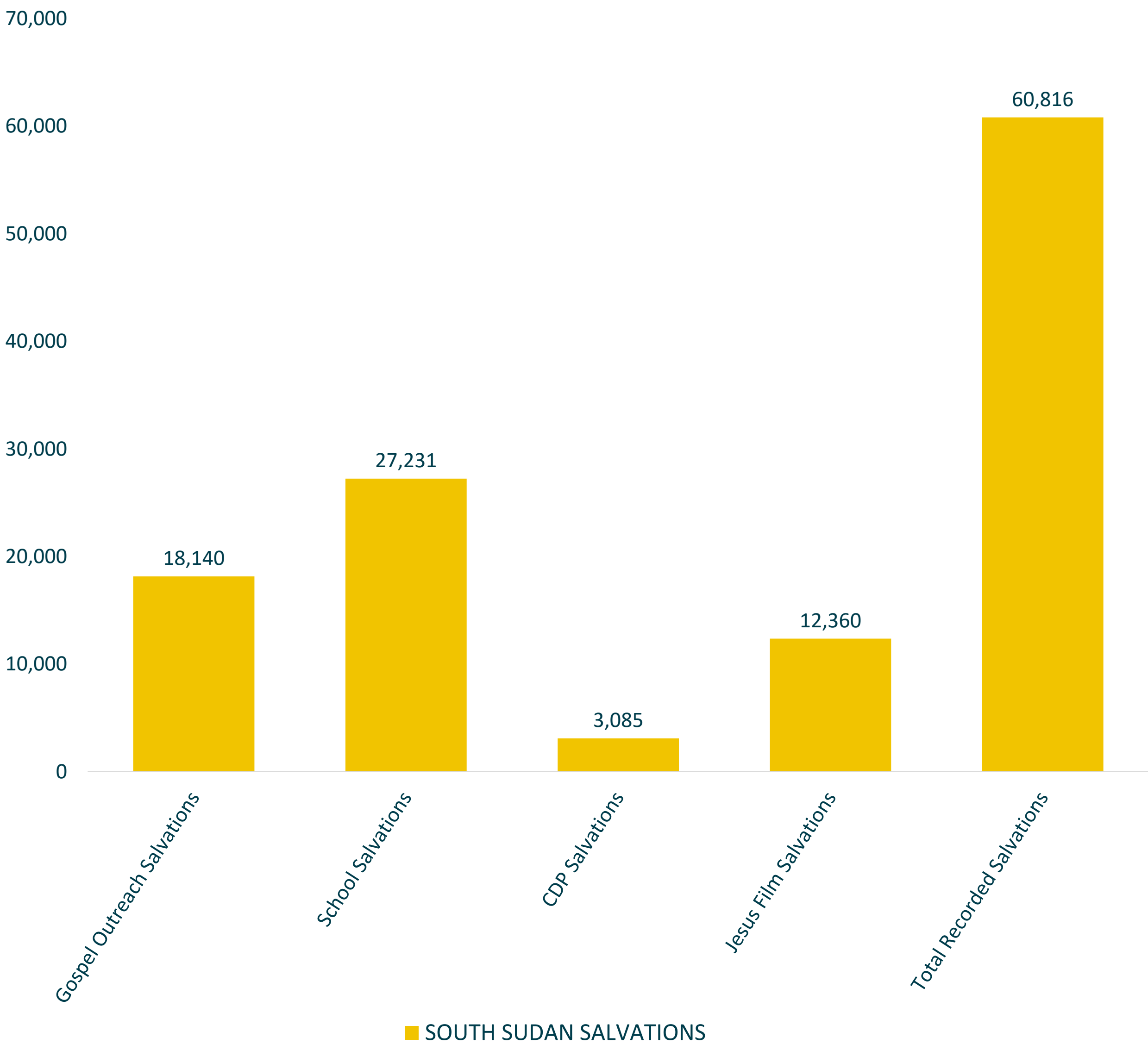
Another significant achievement this quarter was establishing a Christian Discipleship Program for the South Sudan Defence Force. We aim to reach many more army units!

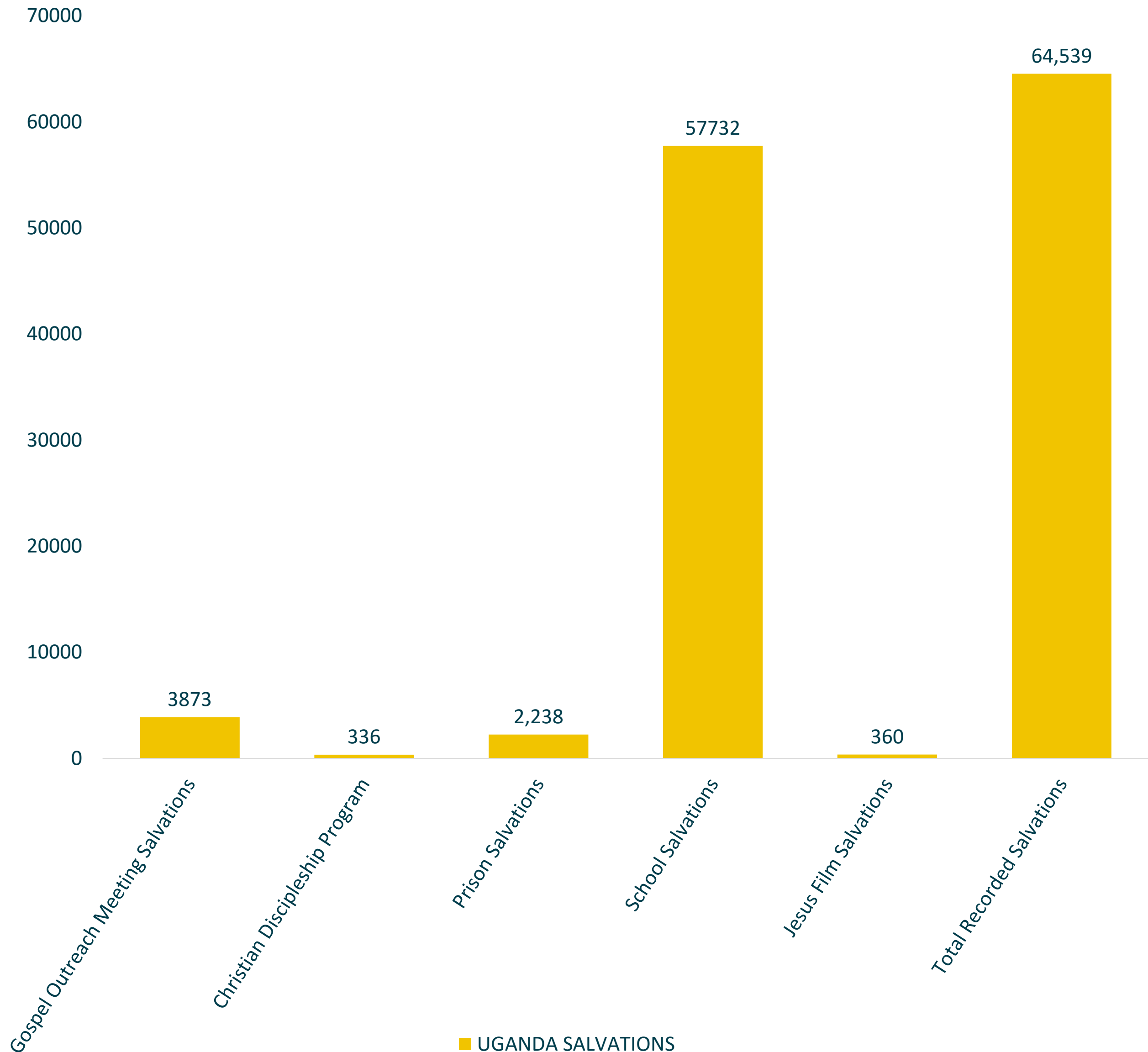

Gospel Outreach Meeting – Owang Village

Lilly Okullu, a 60-year-old woman, testified that she had lived with persistent pain and difficulty walking since a road accident in Loro in 2017. The accident left her with a broken leg that did not heal properly despite receiving medical treatment, causing her years of discomfort and limited mobility.

During the crusade, Lilly remained at home preparing a meal, but because her house is located directly across the road from the crusade grounds, she could clearly hear the worship, preaching, and prayers. As healing was declared over the loudspeakers, she suddenly felt a powerful sensation, which she described as being like lightning, pass through her body. Instantly, the heaviness and pain in her injured leg disappeared!

Realizing she had been completely healed, Lilly immediately ran from her home to the crusade grounds. Overwhelmed with joy, she began dancing and praising God, giving Him all the glory for restoring her leg and enabling her to walk freely without pain for the first time since her accident. Gospel Outreach Meeting – Owang Village

11 healed from long term ear problem!

Simon Peter Okello, a deacon at PAG Central Church, Owang, testified about the miraculous healing of his 11 years old daughter during the crusade. He explained that two years earlier, his daughter had been slapped by someone, after which she developed a condition that left her extremely sensitive to noise. The condition became so severe that she was frequently sent home from school because she could not tolerate the normal sounds of the classroom or any noisy environment. During the week of the crusade, his daughters condition worsened, forcing the school to send her home once again. Simon Peter brought his daughter to the crusade, where, during the praise and worship session, God miraculously healed her. For the first time in two years, his daughter was able to remain in a loud environment without experiencing pain or discomfort from the noise.

The following morning, his daughter confidently asked to return to school, declaring that she had been completely healed.
